

# SETTING UP DNTV SCHEDULER PRO

What is DNTV Scheduler Pro?

Quite simply it's probably one of the best recording programs available for TV Tuners. A single program for all your recording needs. It is supplied FREE to anyone who buys a TV Tuner card with DNTV Live! software from DigitalNow.

Features include:

## **Terrestrial DVB-T device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple captures, up to 10 programs from the same mux frequency using one DVB-T tuner.

Full Mux, TS Mux, DVR-MS, MPG Mux file capture types.

## **Satellite DVB-S device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple captures (using one DVB-S tuner with CA Multi-CAM x8 support) allowing multiple

scrambled captures of programs from the same transponder frequency. Unscrambled programs limited

to a max of 10.

Full Mux, TS Mux, DVR-MS, MPG Mux file capture types.

## **Terrestrial DVB-C device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple captures (using one tuner with CA Multi-CAM x8 support) allowing multiple

scrambled captures of programs from the same transponder frequency. Unscrambled programs limited

to a max of 10.

Full Mux, TS Mux, DVR-MS, MPG Mux file capture types.

Note- This feature remains Untested.

## **Terrestrial ATSC device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple captures up to 10 programs from the same mux frequency, using one ATSC tuner.

Full Mux, TS Mux, DVR-MS, MPG Mux file capture types.

Note- This feature remains Untested.

## **Analog TV/FM device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple Analog TV/FM WDM tuner devices to capture as an MPEG2 Program stream.

This feature is limited to DVR-MS & MPG Mux capture types only.

Requires Cyberlink MPGMuxer, Video & Audio Encoders to be installed.

## **Analog Composite/SVideo device support:-**

Ability to schedule multiple Analog WDM Cross-Bar devices to capture as an MPEG2

Program stream.

This feature is limited to DVR-MS & MPG Mux capture types only.

Requires Cyberlink MPGMuxer, Video & Audio Encoders to be installed.

### **Digital Audio DAB device support**

Ability to schedule DAB device to capture as an MPEG2 Program Stream.

Requires Cyberlink MPGMuxer, Video & Audio Encoders to be installed.

### **Direct action Task Buttons from WEB Page:-**

"View" & "share" Task button available on schedules. These initiate custom tasks for concurrent operations.

### **Share Mode capture types:-**

Three new capture types or mini Timeshift modes can be selected on most device types.

Full Share, TS Share, MpgMux Shared modes allow small timeshift files to be created.

These capture types can be associated with the new share task button option to allow sharing of the device output.

These shared files can be directed to a different location than the normal capture path such as a ramdisk for the purpose of sharing the file over a network with no reliance on the

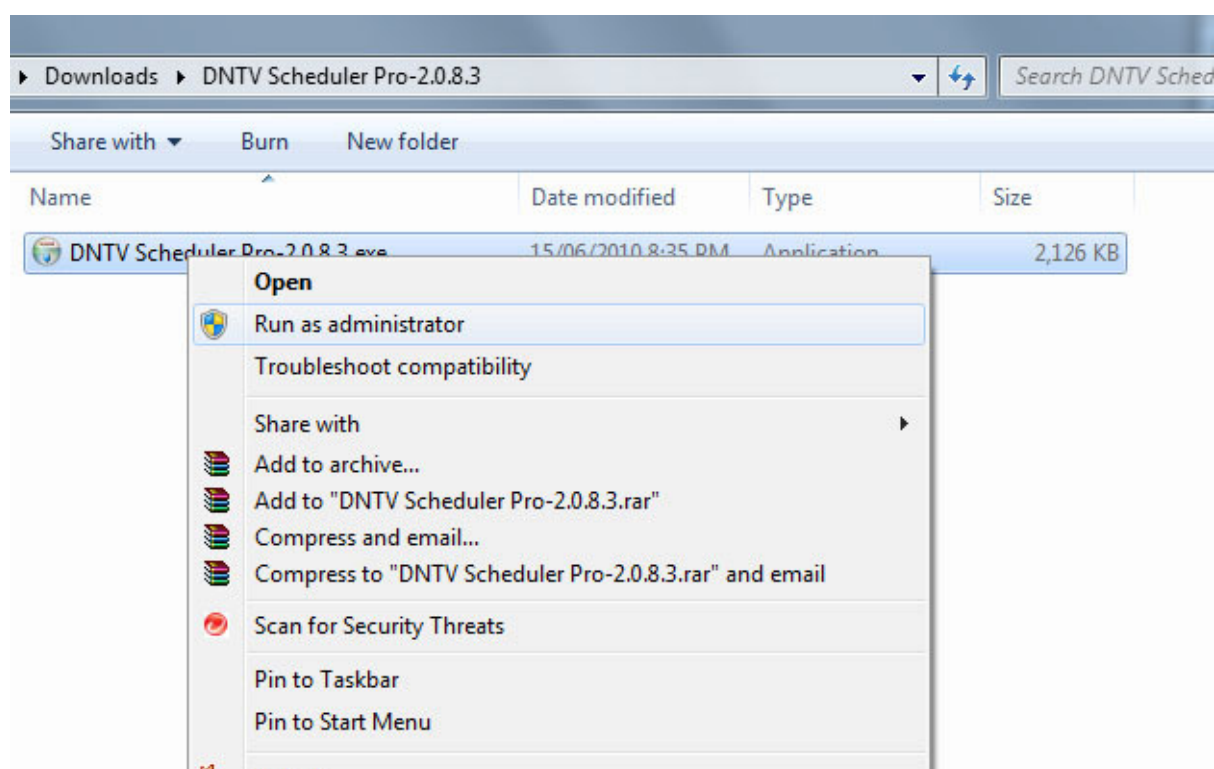
capture HDD device. Continuous file playback is only supported by players that use the TSFileSource Filter for TS & MPG playback.

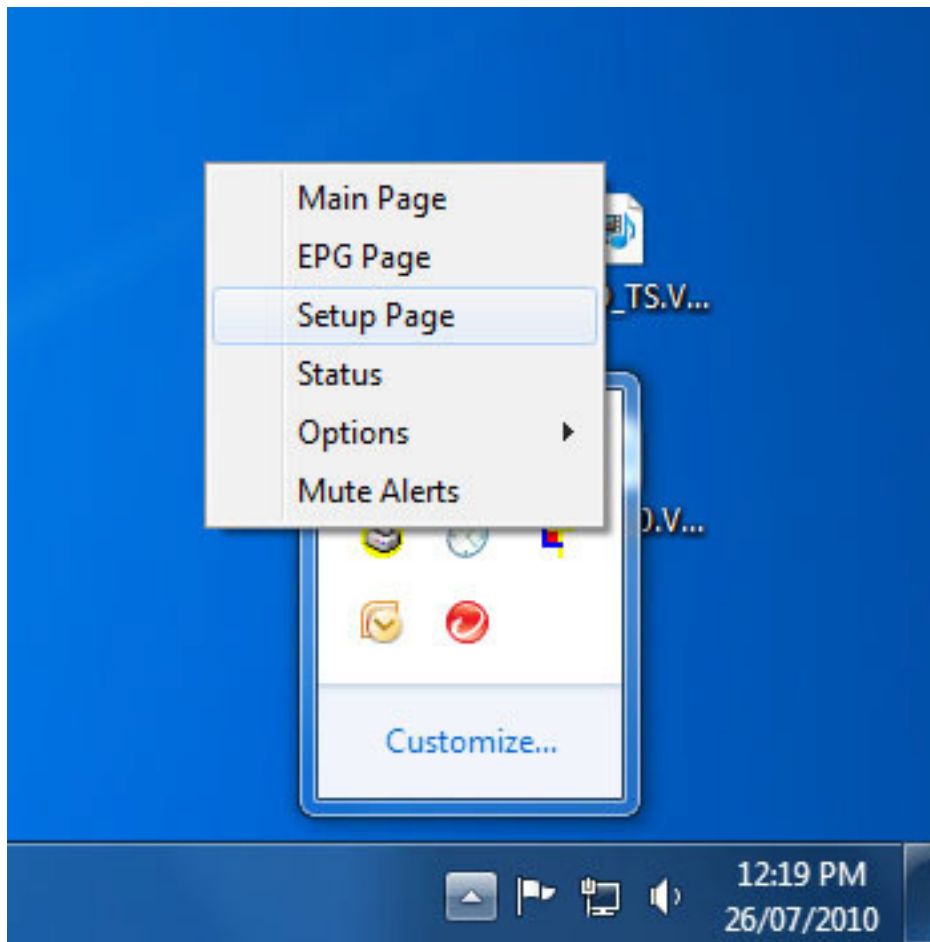
### **Inline EPG parsing:-**

Ability to collect EPG event information during DVB-T/S device capture operation.

1. Ensure that your Tuner Card is correctly fitted in your computer (or in the case of a USB Tuner, attached to a USB 2.0 slot) and the latest drivers for your tuner and Operating System have been installed. You must install the drivers as Administrator. The easiest way is to right-click the driver setup file and click on "Run as Administrator". Reboot if necessary.
2. Download the latest versions of DNTV Live! And DNTV Scheduler Pro software from the DigitalNow website - <http://www.digitalnow.com.au/software.html>. It is recommended that you install DNTV Live! first and after rebooting enter your login/registration details. These details are normally supplied when you purchase your DigitalNow TV tuner and opt for the accompanying software. Without DNTV Live! Installed **and** registered DNTV Scheduler Pro will not work with just any DVB-T tuner that supports DBA drivers but only with certain products sold by DigitalNow. DNTV Live! must be installed using the "Run as Administrator" option on the DNTV Live! executable file. Please take care to carefully read the instructions on the DigitalNow website especially if you have a 64bit system.
3. The last thing to do in preparation is to check you have the latest version of JAVA from [www.java.com](http://www.java.com) and if necessary uninstall the old version and download and install the latest version. I recommend downloading the offline version so that you can install it as Administrator by right-clicking the java executable and selecting "Run as Administrator".
4. If you already have an old version of DNTV Scheduler Pro installed, uninstall it and remove the DNTV Scheduler Pro folder from within Program Files. You are now ready to do a clean install and setup DNTV Scheduler Pro. After downloading the latest version and extracting DNTV Scheduler Pro.exe, the next thing to do is right click on it and click on "Run as Administrator". Accept all the defaults until the installation is complete.



5. Right click on the system tray icon and click on Setup Page to access the main settings.

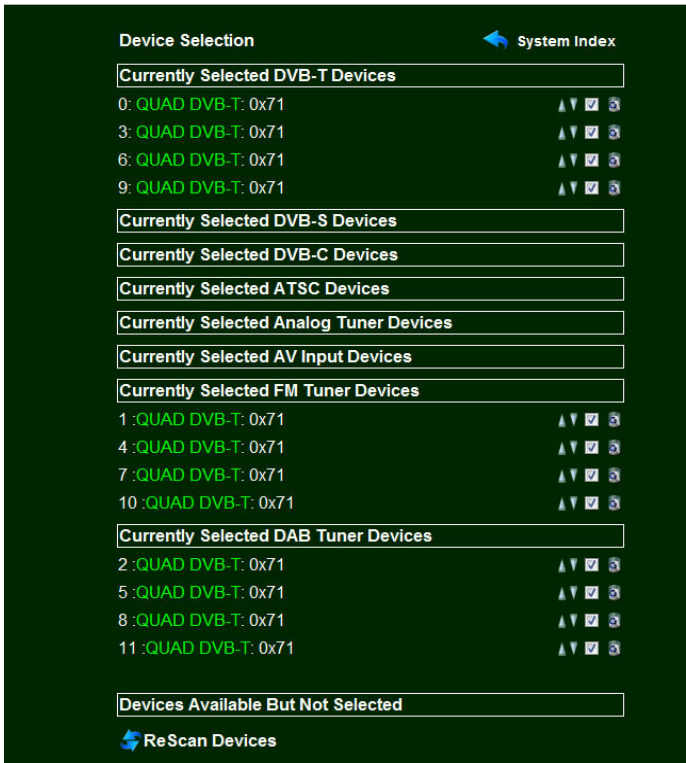


6. Click on “Select Devices” button,

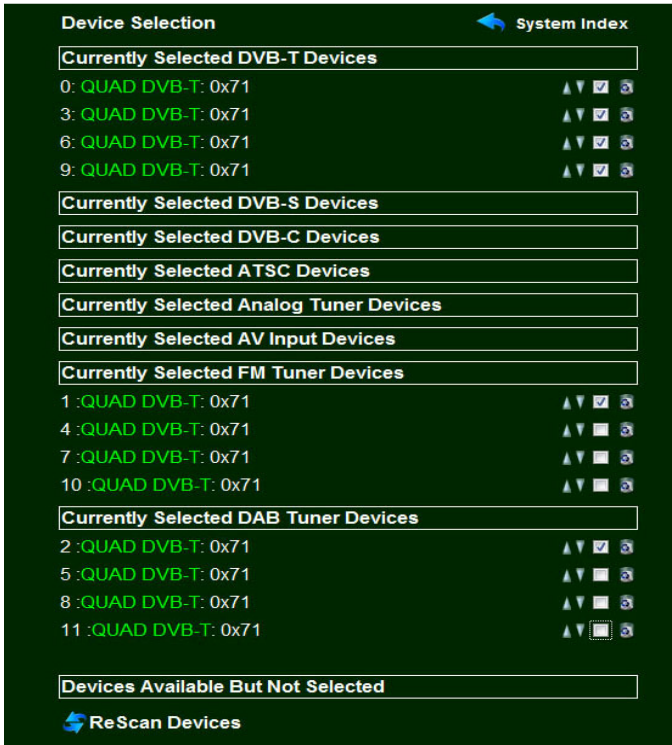




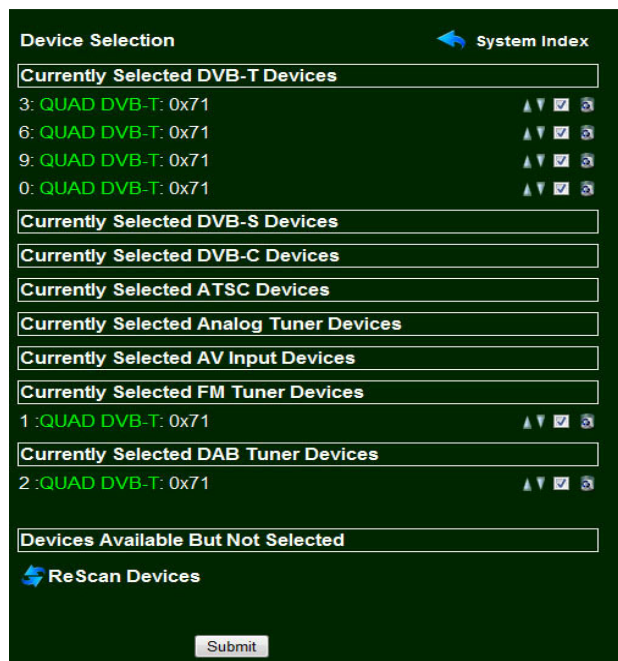
click on "Rescan Devices" icon. (You should be presented with a list of tested devices



check the "Add" box next to the devices you want to add (or untick those that you don't want to be added), and then click on the "Submit" button to activate them.)



If you have more than one tuner, then change the tuner order so that the tuner most likely to be used for watching Live TV is at the bottom of the list and not used for recording till last. Changing the order is a simple matter of clicking on the arrows next to the box on the right of the tuners. When finished click on "Submit" and then "System Index".



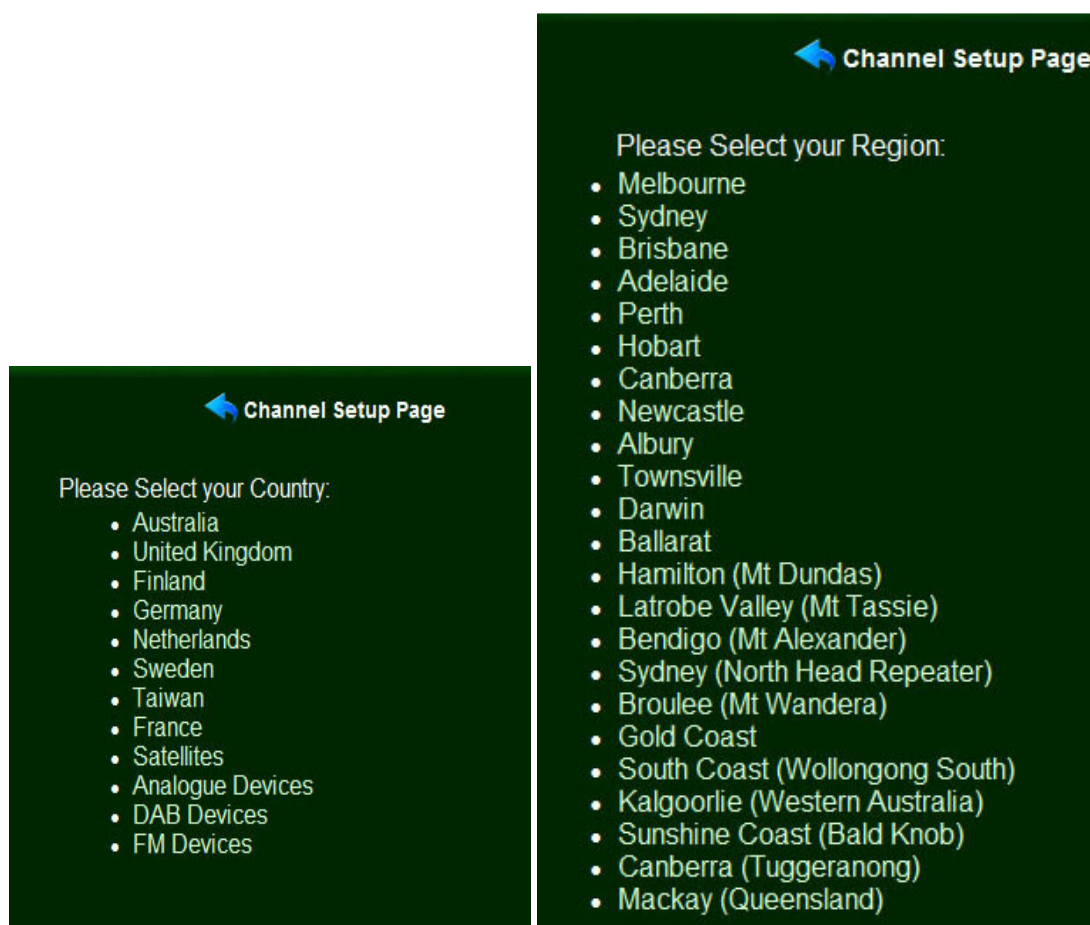
7. On the "System Index" page click on "Channel Settings"



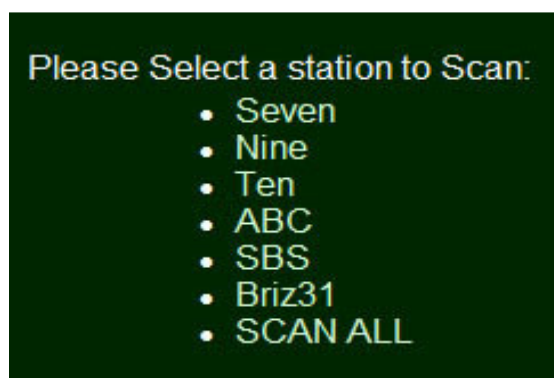
8. Click on the "Auto Scan" icon and navigate to your location and scan your channels.




To setup a DVB-T tuner click “Australia” (or other country where you currently residence) and then select your region (Australia’s listed as an example)



Then click “SCAN ALL”. If updating channel listings then just click on the particular channel. For Brisbane you will choose from:



After scanning you will see a list of all available channels

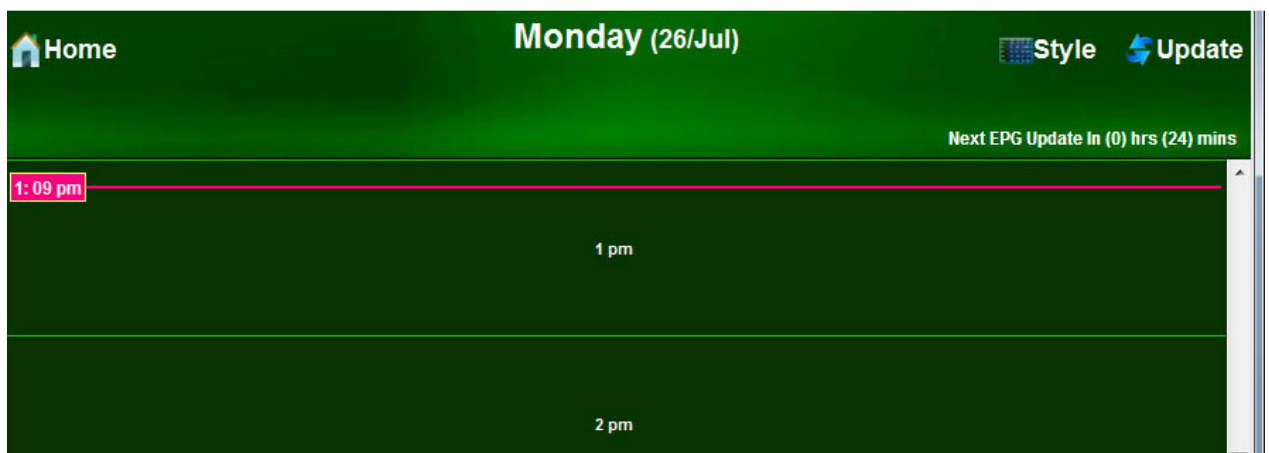
- Return to the "System Index" page and click on "Home" icon, then click on the "Show EPG" button to open the EPG page. (The EPG page will be shown blank with no channels or epg info.)



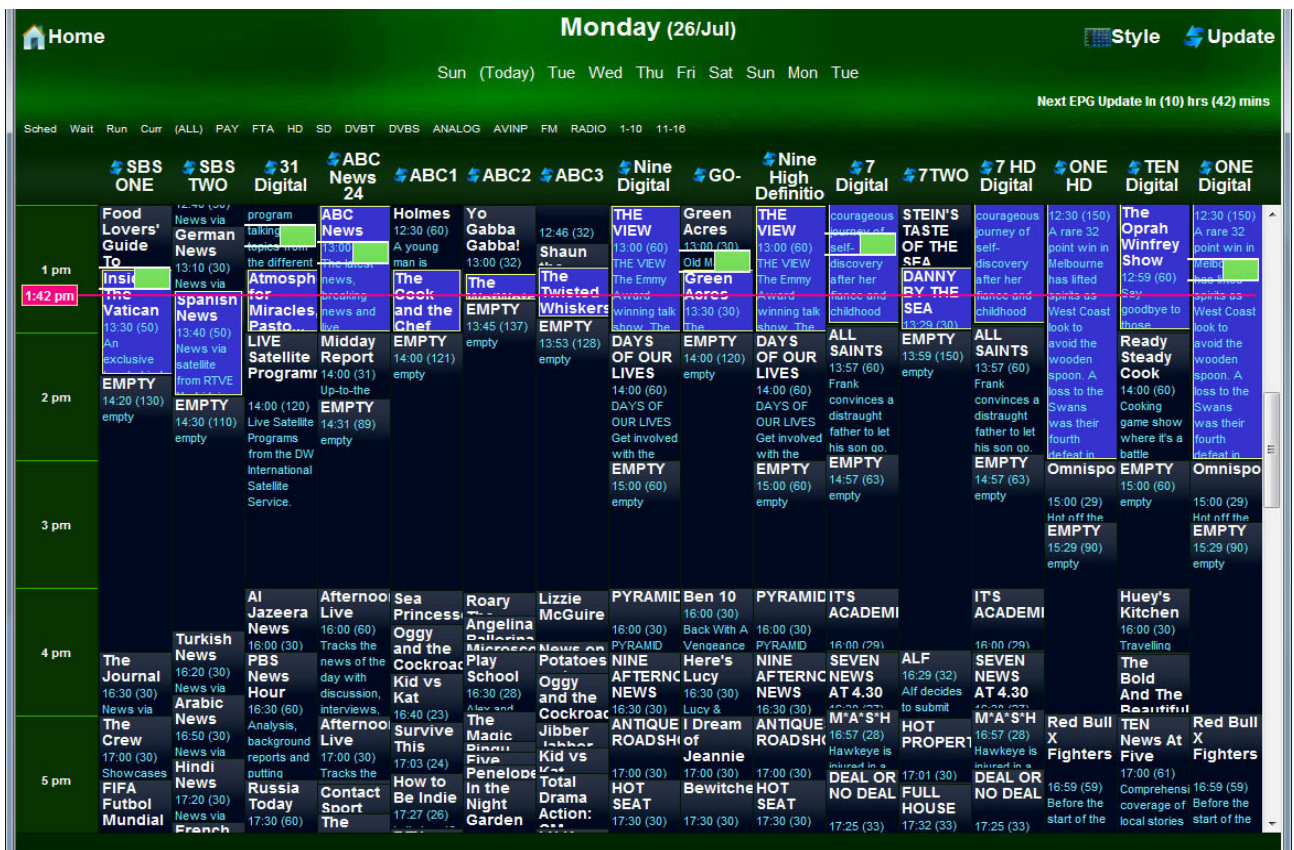
Click on the "Update" icon on the top right of the page to create epgscan schedules for all the transponders in the channel list.



(Note the "Next EPG Update" time is when all of the scanning is expected to be complete.)  
Now wait until the EPG update finishes (this first time could take 1-2 hours)



When the Update finishes it will look something like this:



10. If any channels are missing or the channels are not in your desired order then click on “Home” then “Setup” to get to the “System Index” page. Click on “Channel Mapping”



Some or all channels will have automatically been auto-mapped already but click Auto Map Channels anyway. If any channels are still missing then they need to be mapped manually.

11. Personalise your DNTV Scheduler Pro: Click “Home” and then “Setup” to return to the “System Index” and click “System Config”



“System Config” will configure your settings. Generally the default settings should be accepted. There are a few settings that you may wish to experiment with. The default recording format is TS-Mux but other formats are available built-in just click on the “Capture.deftype” dropdown at the top of the page.

The default recording path is C:\Program Files\DNTV Scheduler Pro\capture. This can be changed by typing in the full path at the “Capture.path” setting

Another setting is the Schedule Recording buffer time. It is the default time that is added at the start (“Schedule.buffer.start”) of a recording and at the end (“Schedule.buffer.end”) of a recording. The default times are 15 minutes at the end and 10 minutes at the start. These times are also used when an auto EPG item is added or you “Add Time” to a schedule through the “Add Time” icon.

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Another setting you may wish to experiment with is the time DNTV Scheduler Pro records the channel stream to obtain the full EPG data for all channels in that channels transponder mux. The default time is 10 minutes and is recommended however you can experiment and may find 5 minutes is adequate in your area. To change the time select from the dropdown at epg.schedule.duration, epg.channel.duration and epg.update.duration or any of them.

**IMPORTANT:** Always leave 1 minute between each schedule so that if the EPG Scan duration is set to 5 minutes then be sure that the start time for each EPG Scan schedule is 6 minutes apart. Once all the EPG Scan schedules have been edited it is easy to check if the start times are correct as they are all lined up in time order.

Once the EPG Scan schedules have been completed click "Home" and then "Setup" to go to "System Index" and again return to "Data Source Setup".

The EPG Scan schedules obtain all the program information however this has to be integrated into the EPG within DNTV Scheduler Pro. To do this automatically go into "Data Source Settings" and enable "Schedule Data Load". This time should be set for 1 minute after the last EPG Scan Schedule finishes.

Enter the security and click "Submit"

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you receive an error relating to java after inserting the security code and clicking "Submit" or "Update" in "Data Source settings" or "System Config" chances are it is caused by your anti-virus program. You will need to add the C:\Program Files\DNTV Scheduler Pro folder to the excluded or safe locations in your anti-virus settings.

## 13. RECORDINGS

There are 3 types of recordings:

1. Single recording by clicking on the EPG entry
2. Auto Add Item for recurring EPG entries eg. A TV Series
3. Manually created schedule

Single recordings are the simplest of all. Just navigate through the EPG to the TV Program you wish to record and click on it. A small window will popup with a choice of 4 icons. For a single recording click on the "Green Cross Icon". That TV Program will be added to the schedules list with the start and end buffers included.

A single recording can be created at any time before the particular TV Program has finished (including the end buffer time).

On the vertical EPG layout it appears as follows:

## FAQ

### **Q. What is the quickest and easiest way to launch DNTV Scheduler Pro?**

A. Right click on the DNTV Scheduler Tray icon in your computer systray. A menu will open and just click on the part of DNTV Scheduler Pro you wish to access, EPG Page, Setup or Main Page.

### **Q. I want to record in .MPEG format but it's not in the dropdown list?**

A. The default recording format is TS-Mux however you can choose DVR-MS if desired. In order to select DNTV Live DNMPgMux (.mpg format) you must have the Cyberlink Encoder installed and registered. Please note the Cyberlink Encoder is totally different to the Cyberlink Decoder commonly found in PowerDVD programs. These encoders are NOT supplied with DNTV Scheduler Pro however if you already have them they can be used. Just look for them by the name of THMPgMux.ax or mpgmux.ax. Once THMPgMux.ax or mpgmux.ax is installed and registered on your system, you will need to reboot then go back to where you were in System Config, and DNTV Live DNMPgMux should now appear on the format dropdown. To record in mpg format from an audio source such as DAB and FM then you also need the Cyberlink encoder CLAudEnc.ax and Cyberlink Decoder claud.ax installed and registered properly on your system.

### **Q. How do I know if my recording is working properly**

A. Two ways actually.

1. The easiest way is to just install VideoLAN VLC Player (It's freeware and available from <http://www.videolan.org/>) then go to your capture folder and drag the recording file onto VLC Player and it will play. You can then see what the quality of the recording is like.
2. Another way is to let DNTV Scheduler Pro do it. To set it up you first need to make sure that your capture folder is shared. Once that's done, install VideoLAN VLC Player then open DNTV Scheduler Pro and navigate to the "Settings Index". Click on "System Config" and find the "Capture.player" setting. The default is disabled. Change this setting to VLC Player. The other setting to change is the "Capture.netpath". The default is blank. Set this to the network address of your capture folder (a simple way to get the correct address is to open your Network and find your computer then double click on it to display the shared folders. Double click on the shared capture folder. In the address bar at the top of explorer will be the netpath <COMPUTER NAME>\<SHARED CAPTURE FOLDER>. This path should be entered at Capture.netpath as \\<COMPUTER NAME>\<SHARED CAPTURE FOLDER>. An example would be [\\MICHAEL-PC\TV](#) Recordings ). Enter the security code and click "Update" to save your settings.

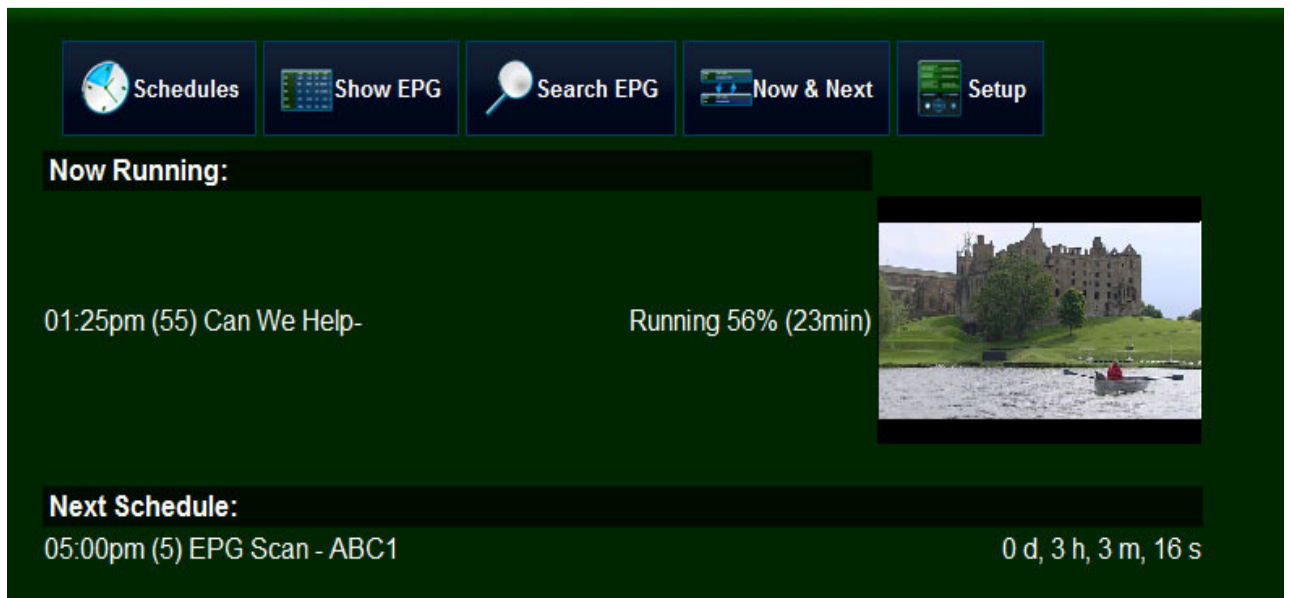

**Q. The TV Program I have scheduled to record started late and is going to finish more than 15 minutes late so even the buffer won't capture it all. Is there any way to extend a recording after it has started?**

A. Yes this is very easy. Navigate to the EPG Page and left click on the recording you wish to extend. A small box will open beside the recording with 3 icons in it. Click on the "Clock with the little green cross" icon (the icon in the middle). This will add an extra 15 minutes (or whatever time you have set in the "Buffer.end" setting in "System Config").

If you wish to add more then just repeat this step.

**Q. Can I start watching a recording before it has finished?**

A. Yes you can. Just install VideoLAN VLC Player (It's freeware and available from <http://www.videolan.org/>) then go to your capture folder and drag the recording file onto VLC Player and it will play.

**Q. Can I cancel or stop a recording after it has started?**

A. Yes you can. Just navigate to the EPG page and left click on the recording. A small box with 3 icons will appear. Click on the "Red X" icon. The box will close and the scheduled recording will turn from red to green.

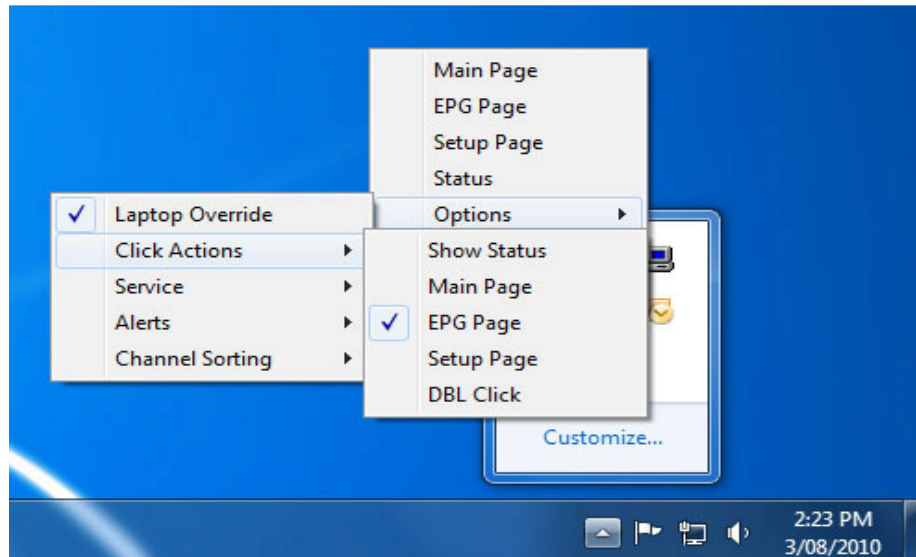

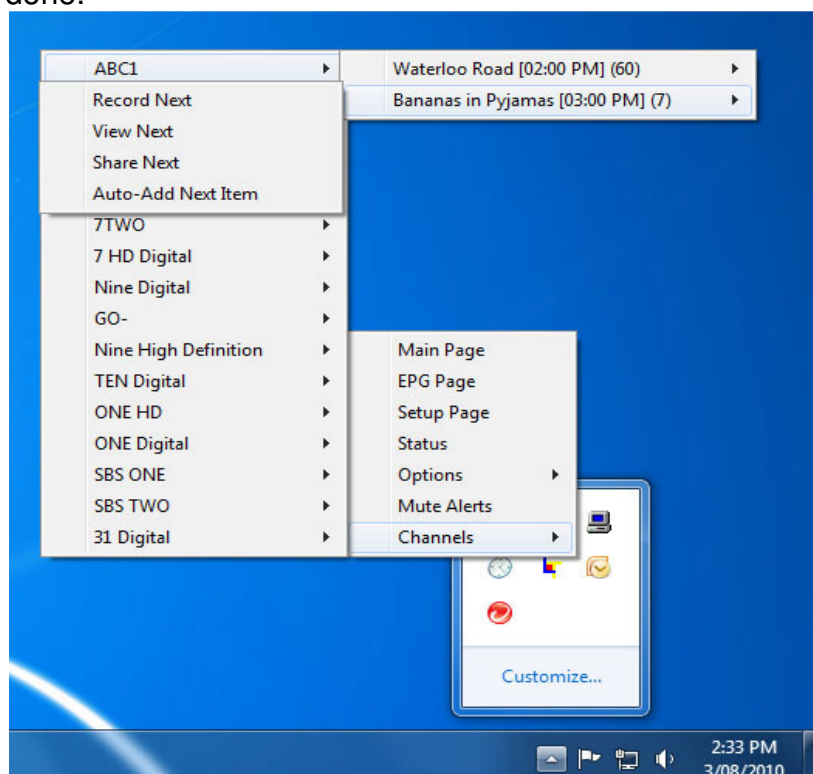
**Q. Can I change the default action of the left-click on the DNTV Scheduler Pro tray icon?**

A. Yes you can. Right click on the tray icon and go to "Options" then on the new menu item that opens go to "Click Options" and a new menu item will open with 5 choices for the default option of the left-click eg. EPG Page



**Q. Is there a quick and easy way to record a TV Show with DNTV Scheduler Pro without having to open DNTV Scheduler Pro?**

A. Yes. Right click on the DNTV Scheduler Pro Tray icon to open the menu, navigate down to Channels and a new Menu will automatically open with all your TV Channels listed. Simply go to the Channel you want to start recording eg. ABC1, navigate across to the TV Show and a menu with recording options will appear. Click on "Record Now". All done.



**Q. Can DNTV Scheduler Pro shutdown my computer after a TV Show has finished recording?**

A. Yes but it must be set up. Navigate to “Settings Index” and click “Edit Task”. This takes you to the “Task Lists”.

To use this task in practice: Create a recording either using the EPG Page or Manually schedule a recording. MAKE SURE THIS IS THE LAST RECORDING YOU INTEND TO DO FOR THE NIGHT AS THE COMPUTER WILL BE SHUTDOWN AFTER IT IS RUN.

Once the recording is scheduled, go to the Main/Home Page and click on “Schedules” and find the recording you wish the computer to be shutdown after. Click on the “Edit Icon” on the right to open the calendar, click on the active date (do not change the date or it will not record when originally intended) to display the settings. You will notice at the bottom right of the page “Post Capture Task”. The SHUTDOWN task will now be listed as an option.
